In the UK alone, his national newspaper daily strips include "Badlands", which ran for a dozen years in The Sun, "The Diary of Rock & Pop" in the Daily Star, "Pop Culture" in Today and "World Soccer Diary" in The Sun.


Over his four-decade career he has regularly graced the pages of soccer magazines Match. Match of the Day and Shoot! and his comics work ranges from Romeo in the 1970s and Look-In. Tiger and Oink! in the 1980s. SI for Kids and FHM in the 1990s, through to the likes of Viz, MAD and Toxic! When The People launched his Steve McGarry's 20th Century Heroes series, they billed him as the world's top cartoonist.

His sports features have been published worldwide since 1982 and he currently has two features - "Biographic" and "Kid Town" - in newspaper syndication, with a client list that includes the New York Daily News and The Washington Post.

In recent years, he has also created story art for such movies as "Despicable Me 2", "The Minions" and "The Secret Life of Pets".

Although Manchester born and bred. Steve has been based in California since 1989. A two-term former President of the National Cartoonists Society, his honours include Illustrator of the Year awards from the NCS and the Australian Cartoonists Association. and he is a recipient of the prestigious Silver T-Square for "outstanding service to the profession of cartooning". In 2013, he was elected President of the NCS Foundation, the charitable arm of the National Cartoonists Society. He is also the founder and director of US comics festival NCSFest.

# WILLIAM ARTHUR BONDS MRE


BILLY BONDS MADE HIS REPUTATION AT CHARLTON ATHLETIC BEFORE JOINING WEST HAM IN 1967, HE WENT ON TO MAKE A CLUB RECORD 799 APPEARANCES IN 21 SEASONS BEFORE RETIRING AND JOINING THE COACHING STAFF IN 1988, LESS THAN TWO YEARS LATER, HE WAS APPOINTED WEST HAM MANAGER, A POSITION HE HELD UNTIL 1994, IN TOTAL, **BONDS** SPENT 27 YEARS AT **UPTON PARK**. IN 2013, **BONDS** WAS THE RECIPIENT OF THE INAUGURAL WEST HAM UNITED LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD.

### "MAD DOG" MANNY




AUSTRIA CAPTAIN EMANUEL POGATETZ SPENT A HALF-SEASON WITH THE HAMMERS ON LOAN FROM VFL WOLFSBURG IN 2013. IT WASN'T HIS FIRST TASTE OF ENGLISH FOOTBALL, HAVING SPENT FIVE YEARS WITH MIDDLESBROUGH EARLIER IN HIS CAREER, AN AGGRESSIVE CENTRE-BACK, HIS TIME IN THE NORTH-EAST WAS MARKED BY HIS POOR DISCIPLINARY RECORD, TWO FRACTURES OF HIS CHEEKBONE AND LOTS OF BLOOD SHED FOR THE CAUSE. HE SPENT MOST OF HIS CAREER IN GERMANY, BUT ENDED HIS PLAYING DAYS BACK IN AUSTRIA WHERE HE SUBSEQUENTLY LAUNCHED A COACHING CAREER.

# MOVING ON UP

AS A PLAYER, KEVIN NOLAN WAS A PROMOTION SPECIALIST. HE WAS STILL A TEEN WHEN HE HELPED BOLTON WANDERERS GAIN PROMOTION TO THE PREMIER LEAGUE IN 2001. AFTER TEN SEASONS AT THE REEBOK STADIUM, DURING WHICH HE BECAME CLUB CAPTAIN, HE MADE THE MOVE TO THE NORTH-EAST IN 2008 AND ALTHOUGH NEWCASTLE UNITED WERE RELEGATED IN HIS FIRST SEASON, HE INSPIRED THE TEAM TO BOUNCE STRAIGHT BACK INTO THE PREMIERSHIP, WINNING THE CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD IN THE PROCESS. SIGNED TO WEST HAM IN 2011, HE CAPTAINED THE HAMMERS TO A PREMIER LEAGUE RETURN IN HIS DEBUT SEASON. FOLLOWING SPELLS AS PLAYER/MANAGER AT LEYTON ORIENT AND NOTTS COUNTY, HE WAS NAMED FIRST TEAM COACH AT WEST HAM IN 2020.



- SIGNED FROM WEST BROM, HE WAS TOP SCORER IN THREE CONSECUTIVE SEASONS, INCLUDING 1980-81 WITH 32 GOALS.
- SCOTTISH STRIKER WHO HIT 28 GOALS IN 1985-86.
- BAD BOY ITALIAN WHO SCORED 17 TIMES IN 1999-2000.
- BELGIAN WINGER WHO TIED WITH **PAUL GODDARD** ON 12 GOALS IN THE 1982-83 SEASON.



## THE BOY WONDERS

BY THE TIME HE WAS 16, JOE COLE WAS THE HOTTEST PROSPECT IN BRITISH FOOTBALL, WITH MANCHESTER UNITED REPORTEDLY OFFERING £10 MILLION TO ACQUIRE HIS SERVICES, HE MADE HIS FIRST-TEAM DEBUT IN JANUARY, 1999 AT THE AGE OF 17 YEARS AND 54 DAYS, COMING ON AS A SUBSTITUTE IN AN FA CUP GAME AGAINST SWANSEA CITY. EIGHT DAYS LATER HE MADE HIS PREMIER LEAGUE DEBUT, AWAY TO MANCHESTER UNITED. HE WAS ONLY 21 YEARS OLD WHEN GLENN ROEDER MADE HIM **WEST HAM** CAPTAIN.

- WHICH CENTRE-BACK MADE HIS **WEST HAM** DEBUT AGED 17 YEARS 3 AND 179 DAYS AGAINST **SHEFFIELD WEDNESDAY** IN 1996, EARNED HIS FIRST ENGLAND CAP AGED 19 YEARS AND 8 DAYS, AND WAS THE WORLD'S MOST EXPENSIVE DEFENDER BY THE AGE OF 22?
- WHICH 17-YEAR-OLD MADE HIS SENIOR DEBUT ON LOAN AT 4 **SWANSEA CITY** IN LATE 1995 AND HIS **HAMMERS** DEBUT, AGED 17 YEARS AND 224 DAYS, AGAINST COVENTRY CITY IN 1996?
