


JAN 1 LEGEND HAS IT THAT **ROBERTO RIVELINO** ONCE SCORED A GOAL DIRECT FROM THE KICK-OFF WHEN HE SPOTTED THAT THE OPPOSITION GOALKEEPER WAS STILL ON HIS KNEES COMPLETING PRE-MATCH PRAYERS! BORN IN SÃO PAULO,

BRAZIL, ON JANUARY 1, 1946, *RIVELINO* BEGAN HIS PLAYING CAREER AS A MIDFIELDER WITH *CORINTHIANS*, LATER MOVING TO *FLUMINESE*. WITH *GERSON* COMMANDING MIDFIELD IN THE 1970 WORLD CUP CAMPAIGN, *RIVELINO* WAS SWITCHED TO THE LEFT WING, WHERE HIS EXPLOSIVE SHOOTING AND LETHAL FREE KICKS WERE A MAJOR FACTOR IN *BRAZIL'S* TRIUMPH. HE WAS OUTSTANDING IN THE 1974 WORLD CUP AND WENT ON TO APPEAR IN THE 1978 FINALS, AFTER WHICH HE TOOK HIS SKILLS TO *AL-HILAL* IN SAUDI ARABIA. HE SCORED 26 GOALS IN 92 GAMES FOR *BRAZIL*, INCLUDING 6 GOALS IN 15 WORLD CUP APPEARANCES.



BORN IN ABIDJAN, CÔTE D'IVOIRE, ON JANUARY 2, 1967, BASILE BOLI WAS RAISED IN FRANCE FROM AN EARLY AGE. BY HIS LATE TEENS, HE WAS A REGULAR FOR AUXERRE AND A FRANCE INTERNATIONAL, EVENTUALLY WINNING 45

CAPS, HE JOINED OLYMPIQUE DE MARSEILLE IN 1990, WHERE HE WON TWO LEAGUE TITLES AND THE UEFA CHAMPIONS LEAGUE. A SEASON IN SCOTLAND WITH **RANGERS** BROUGHT ANOTHER LEAGUE TITLE, BEFORE A RETURN TO FRANCE WITH AS MONACO. HE ENDED HIS CAREER WITH A SPELL IN JAPAN PLAYING FOR URAWA RED DIAMONDS.



JAN 3 BORN IN SOUTHEND-ON-SEA, ON JANUARY 3, 1953, **PETER TAYLOR** WAS PLAYING IN THE THIRD TIER OF LEAGUE
FOOTBALL WITH **CRYSTAL PALACE** WHEN HE WON THE
FIRST OF FOUR **ENGLAND** CAPS. HE WENT ON TO PLAY FOR

A NUMBER OF CLUBS, INCLUDING **TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR**, BEFORE ENTERING MANAGEMENT. HE SIGNED **ROBERTO MANCINI** WHILE IN CHARGE AT **LEICESTER CITY**, AND STEPPED IN AS THE CARETAKER MANAGER OF **ENGLAND** FOR ONE GAME, FOR WHICH HE HANDED **DAVID BECKHAM** THE CAPTAIN'S ARMBAND FOR THE FIRST TIME,


INCLUDING CARETAKERS, THERE HAVE BEEN 19 OTHER MANAGERS OF **ENGLAND** SINCE THE SECOND WORLD WAR - NAME THEM ALL,





JAMES PHILIP MILNER WAS BORN IN LEEDS, ON JANUARY 4, 1986. A PRODUCT OF THE LEEDS UNITED ACADEMY, HE MADE HIS PREMIER LEAGUE DEBUT AT THE AGE OF 16 YEARS AND 309 DAYS, AND BECAME THE YOUNGEST PREMIER

LEAGUE SCORER A FEW DAYS BEFORE HIS 17TH BIRTHDAY, FOLLOWING RELEGATION IN 2004, HE WAS TRANSFERRED TO **NEWCASTLE UNITED**. AFTER GRAEME SOUNESS REPLACED BOBBY ROBSON, MILNER'S OPPORTUNITIES ON TYNESIDE WERE LIMITED AND HE WAS LOANED OUT TO **ASTON VILLA** FOR A SEASON, AFTER SPENDING THE NEXT SEASON BACK WITH **NEWCASTLE**, HE JOINED **VILLA** IN A PERMANENT DEAL IN 2008, TWO YEARS LATER, BY THIS TIME AN ENGLAND INTERNATIONAL, HE SIGNED FOR MANCHESTER CITY. THE 2010 PFA YOUNG PLAYER OF THE YEAR, HE WON TWO LEAGUE TITLES, THE FA CUP AND LEAGUE CUP BEFORE MOVING ON TO LIVERPOOL IN 2015, WHERE HE HAS ADDED THE UEFA CHAMPIONS LEAGUE, UEFA SUPER CUP, FIFA CLUB WORLD CUP AND ANOTHER PREMIER LEAGUE MEDAL TO HIS COLLECTION.





VINNIE JONES WAS BORN IN WATFORD ON JANUARY 5, 1965. HE WORKED AS A HOD CARRIER WHILE PLAYING WITH NON-LEAGUE WEALDSTONE, THEN SPENT A SEASON IN SWEDEN WITH IFK HOLMSUND, BEFORE SIGNING FOR WIMBLEDON IN 1986. TWO YEARS LATER, HE WAS A KEY MEMBER OF THE "CRAZY GANG" SIDE THAT BEAT LIVERPOOL IN THE FA CUP FINAL. AN AGGRESSIVE ENFORCER, HE COURTED CONTROVERSY ON AND OFF THE PITCH, BUT PLAYED FOR A NUMBER OF TOP ENGLISH CLUBS AND CAPTAINED WALES, BEFORE EMBARKING ON A SUCCESSFUL ACTING CAREER.

THE FIRST PLAYER TO BE CAPPED AT EVERY INTERNATIONAL LEVEL FOR **ENGLAND** -- SCHOOLBOY, YOUTH, AMATEUR, UNDER-23 AND SENIOR -- TERENCE FREDERICK **VENABLES** WAS BORN IN DAGENHAM ON JANUARY 6.

1943, FOLLOWING A CAREER THAT TOOK HIM FROM *CHELSEA* TO TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR, QUEENS PARK RANGERS AND CRYSTAL **PALACE**, HE MADE THE TRANSITION TO COACHING, EVENTUALLY TAKING OVER THE REINS OF **ENGLAND**, WHOM HE STEERED TO THE SEMI-FINALS OF EURO 1996.

AWAY FROM FOOTBALL, HIS BUSINESS INTERESTS RAN THE GAMUT FROM BEING CHAIRMAN OF **PORTSMOUTH** FOOTBALL CLUB TO OWNING A HOTEL AND BAR IN SPAIN. HE CO-AUTHORED FIVE NOVELS, CO-CREATED THE SUCCESSFUL TV DETECTIVE SERIES "HAZELL", DEVISED A BOARD GAME AND RECORDED A COVER VERSION OF ELVIS PRESLEY'S "I CAN **DREAM"** THAT REACHED THE UK TOP 30 IN 2010.


TRIVQUIZ by Steve McGarry **EDEN HAZARD** WAS BORN IN LA LOUVIÈRE, BELGIUM, ON JANUARY 7, 1991. **BOTH HIS PARENTS WERE** FOOTBALLERS -- HIS DAD PLAYED FOR R.A.A. LOUVIÉROISE IN THE BELGIAN SECOND DIVISION, AND HIS MOTHER WAS A STRIKER IN THE BELGIAN WOMEN'S FIRST DIVISION. EDEN SIGNED FOR FRENCH CLUB LILLE AT THE AGE OF 14 AND WAS A FIRST TEAM PLAYER BY THE TIME HE WAS 16. THE FIRST NON-FRENCH PLAYER TO WIN THE UNFP YOUNG PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD -- AND THE FIRST TO WIN IT TWICE -- HE WENT ON TO WIN CONSECUTIVE UNFP PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND HELP LILLE WIN A LEAGUE AND CUP DOUBLE. HE SIGNED FOR CHELSEA IN 2012, AND IN SEVEN

ON JANUARY 8, 2004, FLAMBOYANT 5' 6" GOALKEEPER JORGE CAMPOS ANNOUNCED HIS RETIREMENT, DESPITE HIS LACK OF HEIGHT, HE PLAYED 130 TIMES FOR MEXICO, INCLUDING THE 1994 AND 1998 WORLD CUP CAMPAIGNS.

RENOWNED FOR THE GARISH NEON JERSEYS THAT HE DESIGNED AND SPORTED, HE WAS ALSO AN ACCOMPLISHED STRIKER, AND WOULD OFTEN TRANSFER UPFIELD IN THE LATTER STAGES OF A GAME, CAMPOS PLAYED WITH A NUMBER OF PRIMERA DIVISIÓN CLUBS IN MEXICO, AND PLAYED IN THE FIRST THREE SEASONS OF THE MLS.

CLAUDIO PAUL CANIGGIA WAS BORN IN HENDERSON, ARGENTINA, ON JANUARY 9, 1967, HIS BLISTERING SPEED EARNED HIM THE NICKNAME "EL HIJO DEL VIENTO" (THE SON OF THE WIND) AND CULT HERO STATUS DURING A CAREER

THAT SAW HIM PLAY FOR NINE CLUBS IN FIVE DIFFERENT COUNTRIES AND MAKE 50 APPEARANCES FOR ARGENTINA. HE WAS OUTSTANDING IN THE 1990 WORLD CUP BUT WAS SUSPENDED FOR THE FINAL, WHICH ARGENTINA LOST 1-0 TO GERMANY, A KEY PLAYER IN ARGENTINA'S 1994 WORLD CUP SIDE, HE WAS ABSENT FROM THE 1998 TOURNAMENT, PARTLY BECAUSE HE REFUSED TO CUT HIS FLOWING LOCKS TO MEET COACH DANIEL PASSARELLA'S DRESS CODE! HE WAS INCLUDED IN MARCELO BIELSA'S 2002 SQUAD AND, ALTHOUGH HE DIDN'T PLAY, HE MADE HISTORY WHEN HE RECEIVED A RED CARD FOR CURSING AT THE REFEREE FROM THE SIDELINES IN ARGENTINA'S LAST MATCH AGAINST **SWEDEN, BECOMING THE FIRST PLAYER TO BE SENT OFF FROM THE BENCH** IN A WORLD CUP!

THE FIRST PLAYER TO SCORE IN -14 % SIX CONSECUTIVE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONS LEAGUE GAMES, MAROUANE CHAMAKH WAS BORN TO MOROCCAN PARENTS IN TONNEINS, FRANCE, ON JANUARY 10, 1984, HE ESTABLISHED HIS GOALSCORING PROWESS AT BORDEAUX, HELPING THE CLUB TO WIN A LEAGUE AND CUP DOUBLE IN 2009 AND WINNING THE CLUB'S 2010 PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD, BEFORE JOINING ARSENAL, ALTHOUGH HE PLAYED FOR FRANCE AT U-19 LEVEL, HE ELECTED TO PLAY FOR MOROCCO, MAKING HIS SENIOR INTERNATIONAL DEBUT AT THE AGE OF 19, HE PLAYED IN THREE AFRICA CUP OF NATIONS TOURNAMENTS, WINNING A RUNNERS-UP MEDAL IN 2004, AND EVENTUALLY WON 65 CAPS, FOLLOWING A SHORT LOAN SPELL WITH WEST HAM **UNITED, HE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT** CRYSTAL PALACE, BEFORE A BRIEF AND UNHAPPY SPELL AT CARDIFF CITY. HE RETIRED IN 2019 HAVING NOT PLAYED FOR ALMOST TWO AND A
