

On any given day in the United Kingdom, 200 people will be cut down by a stroke. No two strokes are the same, but each can have a potentially devastating impact on the victim's quality of life. Veteran Fleet Street sportswriter Neil Harman suffered a brain haemorrhage on May Bank Holiday 2023, spent four months in hospital, and had to face up to a retirement very different from the one he planned. In Brushes with a Stroke: Seven Survivors and their Stories of Recovery, Neil recounts his own experiences and speaks to athletes of various hues as their lives spin into turmoil, exploring the strength and resilience required to return to some degree of normality. Each one is a vivid account of doubt, fear and, ultimately, fierce determination. This powerful book will provide inspiration to those living each day with the debilitating effects of a stroke, showing there can be light at the end of the tunnel.
