

It then moves to Kenny's most important games for Celtic, Liverpool and Scotland, from league matches to cup wins, to triumphs and near misses in Europe, to World Cup qualifying drama. Discover the relationships in Kenny's career that helped to shape the player he became: from his bond with Bobby Dinnie, the scout who discovered him, to his connection with Celtic reserve team boss Sean Fallon, to his relationships with managers such as Jock Stein and Bob Paisley. The book also explores the bonds Dalglish formed on the pitch, focussing on strike partnerships with Dixie Deans and Ian Rush. Essential reading for all fans of Liverpool, Celtic or Scottish football, this enthralling book unpicks what made Dalglish such a special player for almost 20 years as he won trophies and set records at the top level.
