

Since 1921, Rochdale AFC had always competed in the English Football League. Their continued membership – albeit isolated to the bottom two tiers – was a badge of honour in the face of little on-field success. However, in May 2023, the unthinkable happened and Rochdale AFC were relegated out of the Football League for the first time in the club's history. A nightmare scenario for most football fans, author Chris Fitzgerald decided to embrace Rochdale's new-found non-league status and planned out a season which would see his club compete against the likes of Dorking Wanderers, Ebbsfleet United and Solihull Moors. *Into the Unknown* is the story of a club and its fans finding their feet in the uncharted territory of non-league football ... and the colourful clubs and characters encountered along the way.
