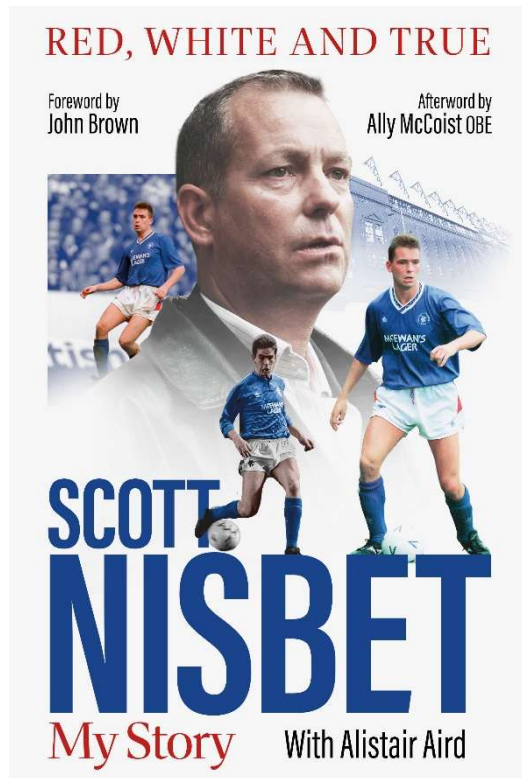

Nisbet made his first-team debut under Jock Wallace as a centre-forward. But when Graeme Souness arrived to revolutionise Rangers in 1986, he was recast as a defender first and foremost. A series of spats with Souness looked like ending his time at Rangers, but Nisbet showed true grit to stay and fight for a first-team place at the club he loved. And when Walter Smith took over from Souness in 1991, Nisbet looked to have won that battle. Sadly, just when he started to become a first-team regular, injury ended his playing career at age 25. Devastated but determined to fight back, Nisbet became a successful businessman involved in running several soccer schools, but this brought him into contact with some nefarious characters. The book reveals the challenges he has overcome since his playing days ended, including his battles since being diagnosed with Stage 4 cancer in 2020.
