

Gilzean emerged a Scottish folk hero having scored the winning goal against England in front of 133,000 at Hampden Park – and was later welcomed back with open arms by the game after ending a self-imposed exile during which the uninformed conjured often defamatory myths. The elegant striker dubbed 'Nureyev in Boots' left us on Sunday, 8 July 2018. There will never be another like him.
