

From the loss of Michael Owen to Real Madrid and the flirtation of Steven Gerrard with José Mourinho's Chelsea, all the way through to the miracle of Istanbul, it was a season like no other. The author, who was on the terraces of the Olympic Stadium for the final, brings us a first-hand account of one of football's most astonishing stories, with views from the pitch and press box.
