

THE FRENCH CONNECTION

IN HIS 22 YEARS AS **ARSENAL** MANAGER, FRENCHMAN **ARSENE WENGER** MADE 126 SIGNINGS ... AND 24 OF THOSE PLAYERS WERE ALSO FRENCH. SOME CAME FROM LEAGUES OTHER THAN FRANCE'S TOP FLIGHT -- **THIERRY HENRY** WAS SIGNED FROM **JUVENTUS**, FOR EXAMPLE -- BUT THE MAJORITY WERE SIGNED FROM A LIGUE 1 CLUB.

IDENTIFY THESE FRENCH PLAYERS SIGNED BY **WENGER**:

- 1** FULL-BACK SIGNED FROM **AUXERRE** IN 2007 FOR £7 MILLION, HE JOINED **MANCHESTER CITY** ON A FREE TRANSFER IN 2014, SHORTLY AFTER WINNING THE FA CUP.
- 2** SIGNED FROM **LORIENT** IN 2010, A CENTRE-BACK OF POLISH HERITAGE WHO WON THREE FA CUPS IN HIS NINE SEASONS WITH **ARSENAL** AND WAS CAPPED 51 TIMES BY **FRANCE**.
- 3** MIDFIELDER WHO HAD TWO SPELLS AT **ARSENAL** UNDER **WENGER**, EITHER SIDE OF FIVE SEASONS WITH **AC MILAN**, DURING WHICH HE WON A SERIE A TITLE. HE JOINED **CRYSTAL PALACE** IN 2016.
- 4** THE FIRST PLAYER TO JOIN **ARSENAL** FROM **MANCHESTER UNITED** SINCE **BRIAN KIDD** IN 1974, A FULL-BACK SIGNED IN 2008 AFTER NINE SEASONS AT OLD TRAFFORD THAT HAD SEEN HIM WIN FIVE PREMIER LEAGUE TITLES, THE UEFA CHAMPIONS LEAGUE, AN FA CUP, A LEAGUE CUP AND AN INTERCONTINENTAL CUP. HE MOVED ON TO **WERDER BREMEN** IN 2010.
- 5** CAPPED 84 TIMES BY **FRANCE**, A CENTRE-BACK WHO WON TWO PREMIER LEAGUE TITLES WITH **CHELSEA**, WAS AWARDED AND STRIPPED OF THE CAPTAINCY IN HIS FOUR SEASONS WITH **ARSENAL**, AND THEN JOINED **TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR** IN 2010.
- 6** CAPPED 21 TIMES BY **FRANCE** AND THREE TIMES BY **CORSICA**, CENTRE-BACK WHO HAD WON HONOURS WITH **AJACCIO**, **MONACO**, **LYON** AND **SEVILLA** PRIOR TO SPENDING THREE RELATIVELY UNHAPPY SEASONS WITH **THE GUNNERS** AFTER JOINING IN A £4 MILLION DEAL IN 2010.

- 7** DEFENSIVE MIDFIELDER SIGNED TO **ARSENAL** AS A TEEN, FOLLOWING LOAN SPELLS WITH **LORIENT**, **SC FREIBURG** AND **CHARLTON ATHLETIC**. HE WON TWO FA CUPS UNDER **WENGER** BEFORE JOINING **VILLARREAL**, WITH WHOM HE WON THE EUROPA LEAGUE IN 2020-21.
- 8** A TITLE WINNER WITH **MONACO**, HE JOINED **ARSENAL** IN 1997 AND WON A LEAGUE AND CUP DOUBLE IN HIS DEBUT SEASON. HE WON A SECOND DOUBLE IN HIS FINAL SEASON WITH **THE GUNNERS** BEFORE HEADING TO THE MLS. HE LATER SCOUTED FOR **ARSENAL**.
- 9** 2001-02 FWA FOOTBALLER OF THE YEAR, A MIDFIELDER WHO WON THE 1998 WORLD CUP AND EURO 2000 WITH **FRANCE**, FOR WHOM HE WAS CAPPED 79 TIMES.
- 10** EURO 2000 WINNER CAPPED 92 TIMES BY **FRANCE**, A FORWARD WHO WON A LEAGUE TITLE WITH **BORDEAUX**, TWO PREMIER LEAGUES WITH **ARSENAL** AND THREE TITLES WITH **LYON**.



EURO HERO



19-YEAR-OLD **BUKAYO SAKA** WAS ONE OF THE STAND-OUT STARS FOR **ENGLAND** AT UEFA EURO 2020, WINNING THE MAN OF THE MATCH AWARD IN THE GROUP GAME AGAINST THE **CZECH REPUBLIC**. HIS TOURNAMENT ENDED IN SADNESS WHEN HE MISSED **ENGLAND'S** FIFTH PENALTY KICK IN THE SHOOTOUT THAT DECIDED THE FINAL TO GIVE **ITALY** THE CROWN.

OVER THE YEARS, A NUMBER OF PLAYERS -- INCLUDING THE LIKES OF **TONY ADAMS, DAVID SEAMAN, ALAN SMITH** AND **JACK WILSHERE** -- HAVE REPRESENTED **ENGLAND** IN A EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP WHILE THEY WERE **ARSENAL** PLAYERS. 
THE BLUES BROTHERS

A PRODUCT OF THE YOUTH SYSTEM AT **ARSENAL**, **FABRICE MUAMBA** REPRESENTED **ENGLAND** AT ALL YOUTH LEVELS AND CAPTAINED THE UNDER-19 SIDE. HE ESTABLISHED HIS REPUTATION AS A DYNAMIC CENTRAL MIDFIELDER WITH **BIRMINGHAM CITY**, MOVING ON TO **BOLTON WANDERERS** IN 2008. DURING AN FA CUP GAME AGAINST **TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR** IN 2012, **FABRICE** SUFFERED A CARDIAC ARREST AND COLLAPSED. AFTER ATTEMPTS TO REVIVE HIM FAILED, THE GAME WAS ABANDONED, AND HE WAS RUSHED TO A NEARBY HOSPITAL. IT WAS LATER REVEALED THAT HIS HEART HAD STOPPED FOR 78 MINUTES. FORTUNATELY, HE RECOVERED -- BUT RETIRED FROM THE GAME ON MEDICAL ADVICE.

IDENTIFY THESE OTHERS WITH **ARSENAL** AND **BIRMINGHAM CITY** LINKS:

- 1** DOGGED BY INJURIES, CENTRAL DEFENDER WHO STRUGGLED TO BECOME A REGULAR AT **ARSENAL** -- DESPITE EARNING A PREMIER LEAGUE WINNER MEDAL IN 2002 -- HE PLAYED 21 TIMES FOR **ENGLAND** IN A CAREER THAT TOOK HIM TO **BIRMINGHAM CITY**, **WEST HAM**, **STOKE CITY**, **BRIGHTON & HOVE ALBION**, **LEICESTER CITY** AND MORE.
- 2** LEGENDARY **ARSENAL** GOALKEEPER WHOSE EARLY CLUBS INCLUDED **LEEDS UNITED**, **PETERBOROUGH UNITED** AND **BIRMINGHAM CITY**.
- 3** POWERFUL DANISH STRIKER WHO WAS LOANED OUT BY **ARSENAL** TO **BIRMINGHAM CITY**, **SUNDERLAND** AND **JUVENTUS** BEFORE JOINING **VFL WOLFSBURG** IN 2014 AFTER A DECADE WITH **THE GUNNERS**.
- 4** **POLAND** DEFENDER SIGNED FROM **LEGIA WARSAW** IN 2014, HE WAS LOANED OUT TO **BIRMINGHAM**, **WALSALL** AND **CHARLTON ATHLETIC** BEFORE JOINING **DERBY COUNTY** IN 2019.
- 5** FULL-BACK WHO, SHORTLY AFTER WINNING THE FA CUP IN 2014, HAD THE FIRST OF TWO LOANS WITH **WEST HAM**, FOLLOWED BY A LOAN PERIOD WITH **BIRMINGHAM CITY**, BEFORE SIGNING FOR **NOTTINGHAM FOREST** IN 2019.

- 6** **LIBERIA** STRIKER WHO PLAYED UNDER **ARSÈNE WENGER** AT **MONACO**, WON A LEAGUE AND FA CUP DOUBLE WITH **THE GUNNERS** IN 1998, SPENT TIME ON LOAN AT **AEK ATHENS**, **BIRMINGHAM CITY** AND **DEN BOSCH**, BEFORE HIS TRAVELS TOOK HIM TO TEAMS IN SCOTLAND, SAUDI ARABIA AND INDONESIA.
- 7** CAPPED 133 TIMES BY **SWEDEN**, HE WON A LEAGUE CUP WITH **BIRMINGHAM** AFTER LEAVING **ARSENAL** IN THE MID-2000S.
- 8** **ENGLAND** WINGER WHO RETIRED AT THE AGE OF 29 IN 2014 AFTER PLAYING FOR **ARSENAL**, **NORWICH CITY**, **BLACKBURN ROVERS**, **TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR**, **BIRMINGHAM CITY**, **WEST HAM UNITED** AND **FC ROSTOV**.
- 9** CAPPED 76 TIMES BY **SWITZERLAND**, CENTRAL DEFENDER WHO SPENT A DECADE WITH **ARSENAL**, DURING WHICH TIME HE SUFFERED A SUCCESSION OF INJURIES AND WAS LOANED OUT TO **BIRMINGHAM CITY** AND CLUBS IN GERMANY. HE LATER PLAYED IN GERMANY, TURKEY, ITALY AND DENMARK BEFORE RETIRING IN THE SUMMER OF 2021.
- 10** WAYWARD WINGER WHO MADE OVER 350 APPEARANCES FOR 15 CLUBS, HE LEFT **ARSENAL** FOR **BIRMINGHAM CITY** IN 2005 AND JOINED **LIVERPOOL** AFTER **THE BLUES** WERE RELEGATED.




EAGLES HAVE LANDED

MAROUANE CHAMAKH WAS BORN TO MOROCCAN PARENTS IN TONNEINS, FRANCE, ON JANUARY 10, 1984. HE ESTABLISHED HIS GOALSCORING PROWESS AT **BORDEAUX**, HELPING THE CLUB TO WIN A LEAGUE AND CUP DOUBLE IN 2009, BEFORE JOINING **ARSENAL** IN THE SUMMER OF 2010. DURING HIS THREE SEASONS WITH **THE GUNNERS** HE BECAME THE FIRST PLAYER TO SCORE IN SIX CONSECUTIVE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONS LEAGUE GAMES.

FOLLOWING A LOAN PERIOD AT **WEST HAM UNITED**, HE JOINED **CRYSTAL PALACE** IN 2013. IDENTIFY THESE OTHERS WHO ALSO PLAYED FOR BOTH **ARSENAL** AND "**THE EAGLES**":

- 1** **ENGLAND** STRIKER WHO PLAYED FOR SIX LONDON CLUBS -- **QPR**, **ARSENAL**, **CRYSTAL PALACE**, **SPURS**, **WEST HAM** AND **MILLWALL** -- AS WELL AS **BORDEAUX**, **MANCHESTER CITY** AND MORE BETWEEN 1978 AND 1995.
- 2** **ENGLAND** STRIKER WHO IS **ARSENAL'S** SECOND-HIGHEST SCORER OF ALL TIME AND **CRYSTAL PALACE'S** THIRD-HIGHEST.
- 3** **SCOTLAND** STRIKER WHO LEFT **ARSENAL** IN 1996, HAD TWO SPELLS AT **MANCHESTER CITY**, TWO SPELLS AT **LEICESTER CITY** AND PLAYED FOR A NUMBER OF OTHER CLUBS, INCLUDING **CRYSTAL PALACE**, **BLACKBURN ROVERS** AND **LEEDS UNITED**.
- 4** **ENGLAND** FULL-BACK, WINNER OF PREMIER LEAGUE TITLES AND FA CUPS WITH **ARSENAL**, AND A PREMIER LEAGUE, CHAMPIONS LEAGUE, AND EUROPA LEAGUE WITH **CHELSEA**, WHO SPENT TIME ON LOAN AT **CRYSTAL PALACE** EARLY IN HIS CAREER.



- 5** **REPUBLIC OF IRELAND** WINGER WHO WAS PLAYER OF THE YEAR AT **CRYSTAL PALACE**, WON A UEFA CUP WINNERS' CUP WITH **ARSENAL** IN 1994, MOVED ON TO **MANCHESTER CITY** AND BECAME A YOUTH TEAM COACH AT **PALACE** IN 2014.
- 6** **ENGLAND'S** SECOND MOST-CAPPED FULL-BACK WHO WAS TWICE **CRYSTAL PALACE** PLAYER OF THE YEAR, AND WON THE 1987 LEAGUE CUP AND WAS PLAYER OF THE YEAR AT **ARSENAL**.



RED & WHITE DRAGONS

AN FA YOUTH CUP WINNER WITH **CRYSTAL PALACE**, **PETER NICHOLAS** HELPED THE CLUB WIN PROMOTION TO THE TOP FLIGHT IN 1979 BUT WAS SOLD TO **ARSENAL** SHORTLY BEFORE **THE EAGLES** SLIPPED BACK DOWN INTO THE SECOND TIER IN 1981. HE EARNED THE FIRST OF HIS 73 CAPS FOR **WALES** IN 1979 AND WENT ON TO CAPTAIN HIS COUNTRY.



- 1** **PETER NICHOLAS** MADE HIS **WALES** DEBUT IN MAY, 1979 AND PLAYED HIS LAST INTERNATIONAL IN NOVEMBER, 1991. NAME ONE OF THE FOUR **WALES** MANAGERS HE PLAYED UNDER.
- 2** BROTHER OF A **LEEDS UNITED** AND **JUVENTUS** LEGEND NICKNAMED "**THE GENTLE GIANT**", WHICH VERSATILE **ARSENAL** PLAYER HAD REPRESENTED **WALES** AT THE 1958 WORLD CUP?
- 3** WHICH **WALES** STAR -- A MEMBER OF THE **GREAT BRITAIN** SQUAD AT THE 2012 OLYMPICS -- WON THREE FA CUPS WITH **ARSENAL** BEFORE SIGNING FOR **JUVENTUS** IN EARLY 2019?
- 4** A LEAGUE AND FA CUP WINNER WITH **ARSENAL**, WHICH **WALES** INTERNATIONAL MANAGED THE NATIONAL TEAM DURING THE FINAL TWO YEARS OF HIS PLAYING CAREER BETWEEN 1954 AND 1956?
- 5** STRIKER CAPPED 51 TIMES BY **WALES**, HE LEFT **ARSENAL** FOR **WEST HAM** IN EARLY 1997, WON MULTIPLE HONOURS WITH **CELTIC** AND SUCCESSFULLY BATTLED CANCER.
- 6** CAPTAIN OF **WALES** AT THE 1958 WORLD CUP, HE SPENT NINE YEARS WITH **ARSENAL**, SANDWICHED BETWEEN TWO SPELLS WITH **NORTHAMPTON TOWN**, THE TEAM HE WOULD LATER MANAGE TWICE. HE ALSO MANAGED **WALES** BETWEEN 1964 AND 1974.
- 7** JOURNEYMAN ENGLISH STRIKER WHO PLAYED FOR **ARSENAL** AND A NUMBER OF CLUBS BEFORE EMBARKING ON A MANAGEMENT CAREER THAT SAW HIM WIN THE 1988 FA CUP WITH **WIMBLEDON** AND SPEND FOUR YEARS MANAGING **WALES** IN THE LATE 1990S.
- 8** GOALKEEPING GREAT WHO WON THE LEAGUE WITH **ARSENAL** IN 1954 AND KEPT GOAL FOR **WALES** AT THE 1958 WORLD CUP.
